IMPORTANT!!!!: For this application you need to have your monitor resolution set to 1024 X 768. If using IE10, you must also be in compatibility mode.

TO USE STORMWATER DISCHARGE SEARCH

Click Run Query

Selecting Specific Criteria:

Enter in one or more of the following fields. You can also use wildcard search techniques.

Permit # - The assigned State Permit number.

Disturbed Area – Amount of acreage disturbed as found in the application.

Comment Deadline – MDE encourages interested citizens to make comments on the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan (ESC Plan) to the Approval Authority before this date. In general, MDE will issue permit coverage after this date if the ESC Plan is approved.

Status –

I – Issued: The project has permit coverage.

P – Pending: The project has a pending application with MDE.

T – Terminated: The project’s permit coverage has been terminated.
W – Withdrawn: The application has been withdrawn.

TO USE THE PENDING ONLY QUERY

Click on “Stormwater Discharge Permit” link on the left side of the screen. Click on “Pending Only”. This query lists all permit applications that are pending at this time.

TO USE THE COMMENT DEADLINE START-END QUERY

Click on “Stormwater Discharge Permit” link on the left side of the screen. Click on “Comment Deadline Start-End Query”. Enter a begin date and an end date for your query using the mm/dd/yyyy format. This query lists all permit applications that have comment deadline dates within the dates you specify.
